FACTSHEET – Election of Elected Charity Trustees

1. How do I stand for election?

You need to complete and return the Elected Charity Trustee Nomination Form by the closing date. Your application requires the support of two Ordinary Members.

To be eligible to stand for election, you need to be an Ordinary Member of PDCT. You can do this online at www.plockton.com. Your application will be tabled at the next Board meeting.

2. What is the election process?

- If the number of valid nominations are less than or equal to the number of places available, these individuals will be returned as Elected Trustees.
- If there are more valid nominations than positions available, then Ordinary Members will be asked to elect their preferred nominees via a postal ballot.
- Ballot papers are to be returned to a nominated address by the closing date.
